## **Mind in Enfield Welfare Benefits Service provides information, advice and support to help individuals apply for entitled welfare benefits and provide representation at welfare benefits appeals, tribunals and reviews.**

The Welfare Benefits Service operates by appointment only. If you have not used the service before you will need to be referred by one of the following professionals:

- \* GP
- \* Consultant Psychiatrist
- \* Social Worker
- \* CPN

One of the above mentioned professionals must refer you using the 'Welfare Benefits Client Referral Form'.

Once the referral form has been received a caseworker will contact you to arrange an appointment. This may take two to three weeks if the service is in high demand. If you have used the service before you do not need to be referred again, please contact us and your name will be added to the waiting list for an appointment.

The Welfare Benefits Service provides help and support to people with enduring mental health issues, age 18 – 65, living in the London Borough of Enfield.
